Nevada County Purchases Subscription to Grant Searching Database Gives Community Access to Funding Sources

The County of Nevada, in partnership with the Center for Nonprofit Leadership, is providing a new grant searching database tool free of charge for local government, community partners, nonprofit organizations and the public. The grant searching database, EfficientGov, focuses on grants and foundation funding for municipalities and non-profit entities, making it possible to identify thousands of opportunities for entities to leverage their current assets and programming through additional financial sources.

EfficientGov is an information service that tracks innovative solutions to fiscal and operational challenges facing cities and towns around the world. Their two-fold operation allows agencies to search for applicable grants while also receiving news and information regarding industry trends and innovative approaches to address service and budget gaps.

The database is accessible at no cost through the Nevada County Library's website at www.mynevadacounty.com/nc/library. The site allows for unlimited access and does not have a time cap per visit so users can take their time to find the grant that is just right for their organization. The County of Nevada is making this service available for one year.

The Center for Non Profit Leadership is letting nonprofit organizations and community partners know this database is available. The Center is a resource for nonprofit organizations and individuals in Nevada County and the Sierra region. The Center works to strengthens nonprofit organizations through workshops, executive leadership seminars, on-site coaching and mentoring, and public advocacy.
