Ability to identify problem areas and provide creative solutions

Strategic Ability to see the big picture and lead the organization in that strategic direction Initiator - Self starter

Ability to negotiate a contract with the County that serves the animals, Sammie's Friends, the County and the Community

Oversee fund raising for the veterinary care of the shelter animals

Good understanding of animal health issues

Good understanding of animal behavior

Ability to develop (with the financial manager) a budget and work to that budget -

Accountability for spending that matches intake of financial resources

Ability to work collaboratively with staff, volunteers, Animal Control and County officials

Ability to work effectively with members of the public

Ability to make discretionary decisions on complex issues (i.e. melding together legal considerations, what's best for the animal, money and people)

Oversee report preparation for the county and Sammie's Friends' Board

Ability to build strong community relationships with donors, veterinarians, other rescues

Ability to establish and maintain a strong relationship with Animal Control

Oversee the marketing and social media activities to ensure our animals get adopted Ability to be interviewed by radio, TV, newspapers and other media when something interesting happens

Strong oral and written presentation skills

Establish a strong presence in the community

Maintain euthanasia rate at less than 1%. Euthanasia is not an option for space

Previous experience in running a fairly complex organization

Working Conditions

Working hours vary and may include weekends, holidays and evenings when necessary Able and willing to work with sick, injured and potentially dangerous animals Able to tolerate loud working conditions and odors associated with animals Capable of lifting 50 lbs., handling dogs weighing 60-80 pounds, Tolerate exposure to cleaning materials, i.e. bleach and disinfectants May at times be required to stand for up to four hours, climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl
